# Payment of forest ecosystem services: solution or illusion ?

The economic situation of forest enterprises has degraded since the eighties in Switzerland and the early nineties in France as timber revenues no longer cover the costs of interventions serving the diverse forest functions and subsidies tend to decrease. At the same time the multiple services of forest ecosystems are playing an increasingly important role and are also recognized for this.

Communal, private and public forest owners seek solutions to finance the costs of the sustainable management of the full array of forest services, even if only to balance their budget. Is the payment of forest ecosystem services a solution? How can the price of these various services be estimated at the level of a forest management unit, including protection against natural risks, water conservation, climate, conservation of biodiversity and landscapes, recreational and educational use, health and quality of life? And through which financial and institutional mechanisms can the various beneficiaries of these multiples forest services contribute to the sustainable management of the forest?

What have been the successes and the difficulties of applying PES systems in general and in particular as it affects our region's forests in Switzerland and in France? These will be the questions that we invite you to discuss on the 27<sup>th</sup> of May 2009, on the occasion of the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the FFL, which will be celebrated in a beautiful setting: La Chartreuse de Pomier!
